Works notification | 3 November 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Upcoming work to Building F

We are replacing the internal walls and ceiling of the storeroom next to the staff kitchen in Building F at Hannam Vale Public School.

This work will include the removal of material known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the school's asbestos management plan, during several weekends in November.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All material is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists to confirm it has been fully remediated, with a clearance certificate issued before the storeroom is reopened.

Satisfactory water quality testing

Further to the works notification on [25 September 2025](#) regarding the drinking water quality test results for Hannam Vale Public School, remediation work has been completed by a qualified and accredited tradesperson following advice by an independent hygienist.

Re-testing of the affected tap outlet by an independent hygienist has returned results that meet the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

Access to the tap outlet, located in the kitchenette in the demountable on the north side of the school, has been restored and can be used again by students and staff.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
