Works notification | 2 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are repairing a broken window in the demountable being used as the Early Childhood Unit at Telarah Public School. Work to repair it will involve working with known asbestos containing material in the window frame.

The window has been covered in plastic sheeting and because the window frame is undamaged the demountable remains safe for occupation.

The window will be repaired on Saturday 19 August 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The demountable will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
