

Hunters Hill Public School

Works notification | 20 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During planned roof replacement works at Hunters Hill Public School, asbestos containing material was found in the roof cavity of Building A. Work was stopped immediately and is currently on hold until the material is removed.

Building A was cordoned off before the maintenance works started and the classroom below is not in use. The affected area is also located within the roof and therefore inaccessible to students, staff, and visitors.

We are following all the advice and protocols of independent asbestos hygienists and other experts.

Work to remove the material will take place after school hours, between Saturday 1 April and Sunday 2 April 2023, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The roof area and the classroom below it will remain cordoned off until the material is removed, and the roof replacement works are finished.

The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the roof works continue.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
