Works notification | 8 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on the remediation actions recently carried out in staff administration rooms 4 and 16 in Building C at Ilford Public School.

On Tuesday 19 August 2025, suspected mould was identified in staff administration rooms 4 and 16 in Building C.

As a result, reactive works to remediate the suspected mould took place between Wednesday 20 August 2025 and Friday 5 September 2025.

Staff were temporarily relocated from the affected rooms on the school site. Access to these rooms remained restricted until the independent hygienist confirmed they are safe to reopen.

An independent hygienist attended the site on Wednesday 3 September 2025 and conducted testing. Results from this testing have confirmed Building C is able to be safely returned to use for staff administration.

As a result, the Department of Education is currently planning upcoming works to improve Building C at your school. A project update notification regarding this work will be issued to the community later this year.

NSW Health advises mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast. Further information can be found on the [NSW Health mould factsheet](#).
