Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our planned maintenance work, we are refurbishing and replacing flooring in 2 practical activities classroom in Block A at Islington Public School.

On Saturday 7 June 2025, we are removing vinyl tiles in these rooms. These tiles contained bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register. These tiles are undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Following the removal and replacement works an independent hygienist will provide clearance to continue using the rooms.

All work involving asbestos-containing material will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
