Works notification | 18 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water was recently tested at Jilliby Public School as part of our routine water quality testing program.

Traces of lead were detected in samples collected from a tap outlet in the Library office, Room 2 (Building J).

The water supply to this tap has been shutoff, and signage has been installed to notify students and staff not to use it. The school has been provided with bottled drinking water for handwashing at this sink.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake the required remediation work.

Works will be carried out on Tuesday 18 March 2025 by qualified and licensed contractors.

When work is complete, the independent hygienist will re-test the outlets to ensure the water meets the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
