Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We have made significant progress in our clean-up and recovery efforts following an accidental fire at Jindera Public School on Wednesday 16 April 2025.

The fire, which originated in the administration building's staffroom, occurred while contractors were on-site carrying out maintenance work.

School operations update

No classrooms across the school site have been affected and all learning areas will be operational on Day 1 Term 2 (Wednesday 30 April).

The staffroom was damaged and will remain out of bounds until the refurbishment is completed.

This will include:

- new carpet tiles and cabinetry
- replacing kitchenette and hot water system
- installing a new split system air conditioning unit
- painting and re-plastering the walls and ceiling.

The office area of the administration building experienced smoke damage – affected areas are being professionally cleaned this week.

We are working with contractors to assess and clean resources.

An independent hygienist will inspect the building before providing clearance for all affected rooms to reopen for Day 1 Term 2.

Following the clearance, all rooms will be repainted and new carpet will be progressively installed.

We will keep the community informed when work is scheduled.
