A project is underway to facilitate a culturally safe, welcoming, and inclusive space for Aboriginal community members and families at Karuah Public School

The project will upgrade the administration building and school hall (Building A) at Karuah Public School, to help reflect the school's commitment to welcoming all Aboriginal community members into the school.

Demolition work requiring removal of asbestos containing material

During demolition works for the upgrade, we are removing wall linings in Building A. This will require working with asbestos containing material in the wall linings and the electrical distribution board backings.

Work to remove the material will take place out of school hours, on Saturday 19 August and Saturday 26 August.

The areas will be cordoned off within the construction zone before removal work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place under the advice of an independent hygienist.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Following the removal the areas will be inspected by the independent occupational hygienist, who will provide the contractor with a clearance certificate before the internal demolition work continues.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
