Works notification | 11 April 2024

Dear staff and parents and carers,

During an inspection at the school on Wednesday 10 April 2024, mould-like residue was found under the carpets in the demountable that houses the library and administration rooms.

Staff were relocated to other rooms within the school and the demountable was cordoned off. Learning won't be impacted as there are no dedicated classrooms within the building. New computers and a printer have been delivered and installed to provide temporary administration facilities.

A cleaning and repair contractor was onsite this morning to inspect the demountable, repair areas where water has entered the building and provide advice on mould remediation.

Planning for remediation works is underway and we will provide updates to the school community as these become available. An independent hygienist will be engaged to monitor the mould remediation work.

The demountable will remain off-limits to staff and students until the end of Term 1 and throughout the Autumn school holidays.

All work involving hazardous materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place while work is being done. All inspections and remediation works will be conducted in accordance with recommendations from the independent hygienist. Use and access to the building will be restricted until a clearance certificate is received.

We will keep the community informed throughout this work.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
