Works notification | 4 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

As part of our regular maintenance schedule, we recently completed drinking water quality testing at Millbank Public School.

This testing is conducted twice a year by an independent hygienist as a precautionary measure at schools that use potable tank water.

This routine testing of 11 outlets around the school was completed on 27 February 2026. The results, received on 27 February 2026, identified bacteria in one tap outlet in the kitchen sink in the Administration building in Building E.

As a safety precaution, access to the affected sink has been restricted. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use the outlet. Bottled water and hand sanitiser will be provided if required to students and staff.

No other drinking water outlets are affected, and they can continue to be used.

Licensed and qualified contractors have been requested to attend site as a priority to carry out remediation works. Once completed, follow-up water testing will be done by our independent hygienist to ensure the water is safe and meets [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).
