

# Kincumber Public School

## Works notification | 17 December 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

On Thursday 11 December 2025, we identified a fragment suspected to contain asbestos on the ground behind the storage shed at Kincumber Public School.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

As a precaution, the area was made out of bounds, the material was removed, and an independent hygienist was engaged to undertake testing and provide advice.

The independent hygienist inspected the area and provided clearance for it to be reopened the same day, Thursday 11 December 2025.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during this work. All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The location where the fragments were found was already listed in the school's asbestos management plan.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
