Works notification | 18 September 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our routine water quality testing program, drinking water at Kingstown Public School was tested on 1 May 2024.

Findings detected lead in samples collected from the bubblers located to the east of Building E.

As a precaution, access to the affected bubblers was restricted, and signage was installed to remind students not to use them.

In the meantime, bottled water was made available to students and staff.

Remediation work on the affected bubblers has now been completed by a qualified and accredited tradesperson, following advice provided by an independent hygienist.

Re-testing of the affected outlets by the independent hygienist has confirmed the results meet the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

Access to the bubblers has been restored, and they are now safe for use by students and staff.

The health and wellbeing of students, staff and the local community is our highest priority.
