Works notification | 3 December 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Kingstown Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

This biannual routine testing was completed on Wednesday 12 November 2025. The results, received on Tuesday 25 November 2025 identified contamination in the school's tank water supply.

As a safety precaution, access to the affected area has been restricted. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use these outlets. We are coordinating with your school to see if bottled water and hand sanitiser is required for staff and students.

Testing confirmed the presence of lead in the following locations:

- Practical activities area in Building C.

Please be advised no other drinking water outlets are affected and therefore they can continue to be used.

Licensed and qualified contractors have been requested to attend site as a priority to carry out remediation works. Once completed, follow-up water testing will be done by our independent hygienist to ensure the water is safe and meets [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).
