

# Kogarah Public School

Works notification | 23 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During recent refurbishments of the boys and girls' toilets at Kogarah Public School, works included remediating asbestos containing material within the ceiling eaves in Building F and G.

The rooms were being safely used last week as the material was undisturbed and out of reach of students and staff.

Works to remove the ceiling eaves took place outside of school hours on Saturday 20 May 2023. The area was cordoned off within a construction site and safety measures and monitoring were in place.

The area was remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The hygienist inspected the ceilings to confirm they had been fully remediated, and the contractor received a clearance certificate before refurbishment works resumed.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
