Works notification | 24 October 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

We are pleased to share that we are upgrading the accessible bathroom facilities in Building D at Kyogle Public School.

Work will start on Saturday 8 November 2025 and will include removal and replacement of wall lining known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed in the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The material is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the wall linings are replaced, we will install new powerpoints and facilities before painting the walls.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
