## Laggan Public School Works notification | 24 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Laggan Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Findings have detected traces of copper in samples collected from a wash trough tap in the boys' toilet block, Building C.

As a precautionary safety measure, access will be restricted to the tap outlet.

Signage will be in place to remind students and staff not to access the tap.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required.

When work is complete, the independent hygienist will re-test the outlets to ensure the water meets the requirements of the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
