Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We have repaired the sewer junction in the front eastern boundary of Mayfield West Public School.

This work was done on **Saturday 21 March 2026** in grounds known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. An exclusion zone was set up around the perimeter of the site while machinery was used for excavation.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists with clearance issued before the area reopened.
