Works notification | 24 May 2024



Dear staff and parents/carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Mayrung Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Samples collected have detected the following:

- lead findings in the sink of Building A
- copper findings in the bubbler outlet
- bacteria in the tap of the water tank and sink of building A.

As a precautionary safety measure, access has been restricted to the taps and signage has been installed to remind students and staff not to use the outlet. Bottled water has been supplied as an alternative for staff and students as needed.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required. All work will be carried out by qualified contractors, and we will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water is safe for use. We will provide an update once we have confirmation of the details of this work.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
