

# Miranda Public School

## Works notification | 18 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are making improvements to the sports court located between Block B and the girls toilets at Miranda Public School.

This work involves resurfacing the sports court with concrete and flexipave sports court coating.

Work started on Thursday 29 May 2025 and is expected to be finished by Saturday 5 July 2025. Safety measures including temporary fencing and signage have been in place since work began.

Hours of work are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm Saturday.

During excavation work on Thursday 12 June 2025, a pipe suspected to contain asbestos was found underneath the sports court inside the fenced off area. This is not listed on the school's Site-Specific Asbestos Management Plan (SSAMP).

The pipe has been left undisturbed and will be removed on Saturday 21 June 2025.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Following the removal of the pipe, the independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate before work to resurface the sports court resumes.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
