## Works notification | 28 November 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Pieces of suspected asbestos-containing materials were found on Monday 18 November 2024 in a stormwater pit at Moama Public School following recent heavy rain.

The fragments are encapsulated in the pit – located between Buildings A and B – which has a solid lid.

An independent hygienist inspected the pit and removed the pieces for testing on Tuesday 19 November.

Any required remediation will take place during the Summer School Holidays – pending the outcome of test results and advice from the hygienist – from the end of the school day on Friday 20 December 2024 up to the first day of Term 1, Friday 31 January 2025.

All work would be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures, including air monitoring, would be in place while work is being done.

All work would be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

We will keep the community updated.
