Works Notification | 26 March 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

The NSW Department of Education is planning to make accessible bathroom modifications to the staff toilets in Building J at Moree Public School.

This work will involve working with asbestos containing material in the toilet partitions, as listed on the school's asbestos register. The partitions are in good condition and the asbestos is undisturbed.

The removal of the partitions will take place on the afternoon of Wednesday 27 March. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

The toilets will be cordoned off and air monitoring will be put in place before the work starts.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The staff toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the toilets are re-opened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
