Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are replacing flooring in 4 classrooms in Building D at Moree Public School.

From after school hours on Friday 30 May 2025 until Sunday 1 June 2025, we will be removing vinyl tiles located under the existing carpet in these rooms. The tiles contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

These tiles are currently undisturbed and in good condition, so the rooms can continue to be accessed as usual.

Once the tiles have been removed by licensed asbestos contractors, the independent hygienist will inspect the work and provide clearance for work to continue to replace flooring. Once the flooring work is finished, the rooms will be reopened for use.

All work involving asbestos-containing material will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
