Works notification | 5 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are making improvements to Morpeth Public School, including repainting the external surfaces of Building A and replacing the carpet in Building B.

This work involves removing lead which is found in the existing paint on the external walls and surfaces of Building A. We are also removing vinyl tiles underneath the existing carpet in Building B, which are known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials and lead will take place from **Saturday 16 May to Sunday 17 May 2026**.

Once removed, the affected areas of the buildings will be inspected by an independent hygienist and clearance will be issued before the improvement works continue.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work will be completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
