

Mortlake Public School

Works notification | 4 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, a project is underway to upgrade Building 5 at Mortlake Public School.

The planning pathway for this project, the Review of Environmental Factors (REF), has been approved, allowing for construction to start.

Start of construction

From Tuesday 17 March 2026 the following activities are expected:

- Site establishment and installation of temporary fencing around Building 5 to isolate the construction zone from students and staff.
- Construction of a new covered walkway between the carpark and Building 5.
- Heritage stoneworks on the eastern side of Building 5 facing Noble Street and on the northern side facing Archer Street.
- Refurbishment of Building 5 including conversion of a storeroom into a teaching space.

Restoration of Building 5 will be delivered in stages to minimise disruption to the school community.

This project is expected to be finished in June 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

What to expect during construction

A contractor site office will be established and access to the north end of the carpark will be restricted to construction staff only. The remaining carpark will be available with restrictions in place for the safety of school staff. We apologise for any temporary inconvenience this may cause.

Construction hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.

Construction vehicles will enter the school via Noble Street. Traffic control will be used as required for the safety of students, staff and the local community. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers when in place.



There may be increased noise and traffic movements along Noble and Archer Streets during this project. We are committed to minimising disruptions where possible while work is taking place.
