Moruya Public School Works notification | 25 October 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The northern wall in a support room in Building J was damaged at Moruya Public School on Wednesday 23 October 2024.

The room was closed as the school's asbestos register lists the wall as containing bonded asbestos.

Classes were relocated to another room in the same building.

NSW Health explains if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low risk.

The department is currently organising for an independent hygienist to attend the school and provide remediation advice.

We will keep the community updated.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours, in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The room will be inspected by a hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before the room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
