## Works notification | 10 December 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers and neighbours,

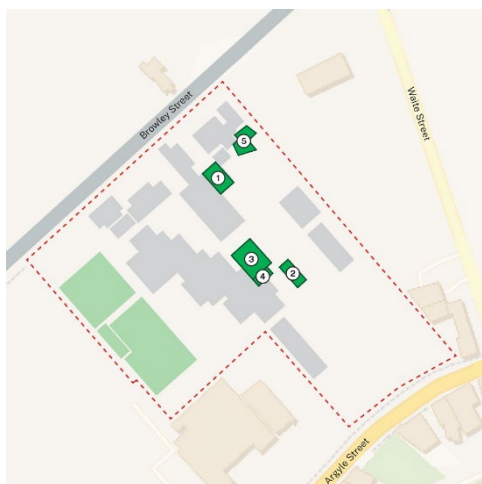
We are continuing to manage known in-ground bonded asbestos at Moss Vale Public School site as [we notified you on 25 November 2024](#).

Following a site visit by an independent hygienist on 27 November, proactive weekly assessments will continue for the remainder of Term 4.

A site-specific asbestos management plan has been created that outlines areas where in-ground materials were found.

The map below shows the areas where asbestos has been found.

Areas 1, 2, 4 and 5 have all had removal work completed and following the hygienist's advice, they have reopened.



### Summer holiday works

The hygienist advised that further asbestos removal and remediation work is required in area 3 (outside Building A).

During the upcoming Summer School Holidays, which may include from the end of the school day on Friday 20 December 2024 up to the first day of Term 1 Friday 31 January 2025, we will be undertaking a range of works.

This work will require the use of heavy machinery such as excavators and trucks with increased vehicle movements around and on the school site.

The area will remain cordoned off with temporary fencing until this work is completed and the independent hygienist provides a clearance certificate.

Safety measures including air monitoring and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place while work is being done.
