

Mount Pleasant Public School

Works notification | 7 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Mount Pleasant Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Findings have detected lead in samples collected from the sink and tank in Building G, the block near the front gate.

As a precautionary safety measure, access has been restricted to those water outlets. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to access them.

Bottled water is being arranged for drinking and handwashing. Alternative water outlets in the school are also available to use. We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required as quickly as possible so that affected water outlets are ready for students to use again soon.

All work will be carried out by qualified contractors. When work is complete, the independent hygienist will re-test the outlets to ensure the water meets the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
