

Mount Pritchard Public School

Fencing works notification | 1 April 2026

Dear neighbour,

The shared boundary fence between your property and Mount Pritchard Public School has fallen and needs to be replaced.

The NSW Department of Education will be replacing the shared boundary fence at no cost to you.

Work to replace the fence will take place from Monday 13 April 2026 and is expected to be completed by Wednesday 15 April 2026, weather permitting. Work hours are between 7 am to 5 pm in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

We will supply and install a new 1800mm-high treated pine close-paling fence, incorporating a three-rail system (75x50mm rails). The fence will be supported by 75x75mm, 2.5mm galvanised steel end posts and 50x50mm, 2.5mm intermediate posts, all set in 600x200mm concrete footings.

The works will be carried out using post hole diggers, with temporary fencing installed as required to ensure site safety during construction.

For the safety of the contractors, please secure your pets and keep them away from the work area during the scheduled work times.
