

Mount Victoria Public School

Works notification | 26 August 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 13 August 2024, fragments of building material were found on the ground of the preschool play area on the northern side of Building C at Mount Victoria Public School.

The area where the fragments were found is listed on the school's site-specific asbestos management plan (SSAMP). The area was locked immediately and access restricted.

We engaged an independent hygienist to inspect the area, conduct air monitoring and organise the samples for testing.

On 16 August 2024, test results confirmed the fragments do not contain asbestos.

Air monitoring returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines.

The independent hygienist provided a clearance certificate, and the play area was reopened for normal use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
