

Murrumburrah Public School

Works notification | 5 February 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Over the Summer school holidays fragments of ceiling material with suspected asbestos containing material was found on the ground near an undercover walkway at Murrumburrah Public School.

The fragments were secured, and the area was made out of bounds. An independent occupational hygienist inspected the area to collect samples for testing and as an additional safety measure, air monitoring was put in place.

Testing confirmed that the material did contain asbestos and remediation work started on 19 January 2024.

Work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area was inspected after work was completed and the school received a clearance certificate before the area was made accessible again.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
