Narrabeen Lakes Public School Works notification | 29 August 2024

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours

Following on from the notification on <u>25 July 2024</u>, we are continuing to manage the in-ground asbestos in the playground near Building U (Outside of School Hours Care Building) at Narrabeen Lakes Public School. This area is currently fenced off.

Following advice from the independent hygienist, we will be working on the next stages of the site-specific asbestos management plan.

This work will include the removal of a 150mm-deep layer of existing soil, upgrades to soil drainage and the installation of a synthetic turf layer to secure the soil. Synthetic turf will secure the ground and prevent movement of the soil underneath.

This work has been scheduled to take place outside of school hours on Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 September 2024.

Work will be done under the supervision of an independent hygienist with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place before the work starts.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Following the work, the area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the space is reopened for use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
