

# Nemingha Public School

## Works notification | 22 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on the remediation actions recently carried out at Nemingha Public School in a demountable classroom behind Block C.

As notified on 28 August 2025 [Works notification - 28 August 2025](#), on 22 August 2025 a staff member noticed wet carpet in the corner of the classroom and discovered mould. The school immediately relocated students and staff to another room while the issue was investigated and fixed.

Cleaning and plumbing specialists attended the site and found moisture in the walls and flooring caused by groundwater pooling under the demountable after rain. The following actions were completed:

- The affected area was treated for mould and drying equipment installed to remove moisture.
- The carpet and underlay were removed.
- Ongoing monitoring and drying continued until the flooring and walls were completely dry.
- The eastern wall was sealed with silicone and a mechanism installed to divert rainwater away from the building.
- A new stormwater pit and pump were installed to prevent future water build-up under the demountable.
- New floor coverings were laid, and final moisture tests confirmed the area is dry and safe.

All work involving mould took place outside of school hours, with appropriate safety measures in place. Use and access to the building were restricted until the area was fully remediated.

NSW Health advises that mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.
