

Nemingha Public School

Works notification | 28 August 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Friday 22 August 2025, a classroom teacher found suspected mould in the carpet in a demountable classroom at Nemingha Public School.

An independent hygienist attended the site the same day and conducted testing, which confirmed the presence of mould.

As a result, reactive works to remediate the mould have started and will be taking place between Monday 25 August and Thursday 28 August 2025 between 7:30 am - 6 pm.

As a precautionary measure, students and staff have been relocated from the affected demountable classroom to the school library, on the school site. Access to the demountable classroom will remain restricted until the independent hygienist confirms it is safe to reopen.

NSW Health advises mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast. Further information can be found on the [NSW Health mould factsheet](#).

We will continue to keep the community informed as the works progress.
