Works notification | 14 October 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We have fixed a window from an office in the administration building over the weekend at New Lambton Public School, 20 and 21 September 2025.

The putty around the window was known to contain bonded asbestos.

On finding the broken window, it was immediately boarded up until contractors could remove the putty and replace the window.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

A licensed contractor was engaged on 20 September 2025 to remove the asbestos and replace the window under the guidance of an independent hygienist.

The building was then cleared by the hygienist before it was reopened.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Safety measures including workers wearing personal protective equipment and air monitoring were in place.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
