The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

## Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays

As part of planned maintenance, we are removing a tree from the grounds of Normanhurst Public School.

Following recent storms and the department's Annual Tree Safety inspection, a tree with potential safety issues was identified at Normanhurst Public School. The tree is located in between the library and a demountable classroom near the main entrance of the school off Normanhurst Road. The removal of this tree has been approved by the local council.

The result of the arborist inspection and report recommended the removal of a Eucalyptus saligna commonly known as a Sydney Blue Gum tree.

The qualified arborist will remove the tree during the holidays on Tuesday 29 April 2025, which is a staff development day.

The vacation care program will be open as usual on this date. The vacation care program (Building J) is located away from the work at the south end of the school.

## What to expect

On Tuesday 29 April 2025, the tree removal area will be fenced off and there will be no access to school from the main gate on Normanhurst Road.

The school community (staff and vacation care community) will be able to access the school via the Fraser Road carpark entrance or upper entrance gate on Normanhurst Road.

During the works, there will be temporary fencing and signage installed. Work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm in accordance with NSW Environment Protection Authority construction times.

On this day, parking and drop-off for vacation care will be either via the Fraser Road carpark or you will need to find street parking nearby.
