Nulkaba Public School School holiday works notification – Summer | January 2024

Lane closed on Rothbury St

The planned work outlined in the notification below has been updated to reflect the latest traffic management plan.

Updated information

Lights will no longer be installed along the one-way traffic zone on Rothbury St and detours will be in place on the Ivanhoe St and Rothbury St intersection to prevent unnecessary traffic from entering Rothbury St during the works.

Dear staff, parents/carers and residents

We are preparing for the construction of an accessible school drop-off zone for Nulkaba Public School. This will ensure students can access the school campus as quickly and safely as possible. The new accessible drop-off will be located along the Rothbury Street entrance.

Planned work includes removing 2 trees, installing kerbed pathways, laying new asphalt, and adjustments to existing pathways and adjoining garden beds to assist accessibility.

This work will start during the Summer school holiday period and continue through early Term 1 2024.

Work along Rothbury Street January – February 2024, partial road closure

Construction on the new drop-off zone starting from 5 January 2024 and will involve a partial road closure of Rothbury Street, supported by traffic management.

During the work, traffic on Rothbury St will be limited to one lane, travelling one way between O'Connor Rd and Ivanhoe St intersections. Traffic along Rothbury St will be limited to one way travelling south, allowing access from O'Connor Rd. Detours will be in place on the Ivanhoe St and Rothbury St intersection to prevent traffic from entering Rothbury St from Ivanhoe St during the works.

Traffic flow will be managed by accredited traffic control. Residents will have full access to their driveways during this time.

The work is scheduled to be finished at the end of February 2024.



The approved hours of work are 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00 am to 1:00 pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Rothbury Street pedestrian entrance

During the work, a temporary barricaded passageway will be used for students who enter using the Rothbury Street entrance. This will lead to the current pedestrian gate to allow safe access to the school.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity. All work will be done in accordance with relevant council approvals.
