Works notification

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Upcoming maintenance works to remediate the roof of a demountable following a vandalism incident at Pennant Hills Public School will involve working with suspected asbestos containing material. The demountable (D14562) is being used as a general learning space.

Work will take place on Wednesday 12 October 2022. All asbestos containing material will be removed outside of school hours and in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

The area is cordoned off, and additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place before works start. It will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is completed.

This area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
