Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will be upgrading the demountable girls toilets located on the Years 3-6 (Wemeela) side of Pennant Hills Public School.

To prepare for this work, we will be removing and replacing the ceiling and cubicle partition walls in the demountable which are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work involving asbestos-containing materials will be completed outside of school hours on Saturday 7 June 2025.

While these upgrades are being done this demountable toilet will remain isolated within a construction area and students will be redirected to use alternative toilets at the school. The upgrade is due to be completed by late June 2025.

During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
