

West Pennant Hills Public School

Works notification – 10 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As part of our proactive maintenance schedule, replacement of existing carpet and vinyl tiles is underway in several classrooms and adjoining storerooms in Building A at West Pennant Hills Public School.

As part of these works, we will be removing bonded asbestos vinyl tiles. These areas are listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Works are scheduled to take place on Saturday 21 March 2026 and Sunday 22 March 2026, between 8 am and 1 pm, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The classrooms and storerooms will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before they are reopened for teaching and learning.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
