

# Penrose Public School

## Works notification | 24 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Penrose Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Findings have detected copper and lead in samples collected from:

- bubblers outside the toilets in Building D
- handwashing sink tap in Building G

As a precautionary safety measure, access has been restricted to the tap outlets.

Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to access the taps. Bottled water and hand sanitiser is being supplied for students and staff as needed.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required.

All work will be carried out by qualified contractors, and we will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water can continue to be used.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
