

Port Macquarie Public School

Works notification | 8 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will be removing a window panel in the centre room of Building H at Port Macquarie Public School.

A piece of the window panel was removed for testing and came back positive for bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials will be completed outside of school hours on Saturday 13 September 2025.

The area will remain cordoned off until the removal work is finished. While work is taking place there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

The Outside of School Hours (OOSH) service is unaffected and will operate as usual.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
