

Pretty Beach Public School

Works notification | 17 December 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

On Thursday 11 December 2025 we identified a fragment suspected to contain asbestos on the ground next to the demountable classroom at Pretty Beach Public School.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

As a precaution, the area was made out of bounds, and an independent hygienist was engaged to undertake testing and provide advice.

Work to remove the material and clear the surrounding soil took place on Thursday 11 December 2025. and the independent hygienist inspected the area and provided clearance for it to be reopened.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during this work. All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
