

Primbee Public School

Works notification | 2 July 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During scheduled repair work of the shade structure outside of Building A at Primbee Public School on Monday 23 June 2025, bonded asbestos was found in the ground.

Work was immediately stopped, and the area was covered in black construction plastic.

From Saturday 5 July 2025 to Friday 18 July 2025 contractors will remove soil from the area before continuing the planned repair work including the pouring of a new concrete slab.

It is expected that all shade structure repair work will be finished by the end of Week 2 Term 3 2025, weather permitting.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before work is continued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
