Works notification | 14 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

A fragment of suspected asbestos containing material has been found in the garden in front of Building B's veranda at Putney Public School. The fragment was immediately removed and secured.

We are following all the advice and protocols of independent asbestos hygienists and other experts.

As a precaution, the area around where the material was found has been fenced and secured so that it is out of bounds to anyone on site.

Testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist on Monday 14 August 2023 to confirm the nature of the material.

If necessary, the area will be cleared in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully cleared and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
