

# Rand Public School

## Works notification | 30 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During scheduled refurbishment work of the student toilets in Building A at Rand Public School, asbestos-containing material was found in the wall lining by the contractor on Monday 23 June 2025.

As refurbishment work was in progress, the toilets were already locked to students and staff.

Work was stopped to avoid damaging the wall lining and the area inside the construction zone containing the asbestos was cordoned off.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The asbestos-containing material was removed on Saturday 28 June 2025.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the refurbishment work continues.

Work is expected to finish during the upcoming Winter School Holidays with the toilets opening for students to use from Day 1 Term 3 2025.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
