

# Red Range Public School

## Works notification | 22 May 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and local community remain our highest priorities.

On Wednesday 20 May 2026, a contractor attended the Red Range Public School to replace an overflow pipe connected to a drinkable potable water tank that had recently been damaged. As a result of the damage, water supply to the following areas in Building A is affected:

- water filtration unit
- staff room
- staff kitchen
- school kitchenette
- school canteen
- multiple practical activities areas.

No other drinking water outlets at the school have been identified as affected.

Access to the affected water outlets has been restricted on Wednesday 20 May 2026. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use these outlets. We have coordinated with your school for bottled water and hand sanitisers are available for students and staff.

### Improvement works

The department will be proactively investigating the damage and are fixing the water tank.

Licensed and qualified contractors have been requested to attend as a priority to carry out the works which include:

- updating the school's filtration systems
- flushing the pipelines
- overflow pipework replacement
- replacement of water supply in tank 1 connected to Building A.

We anticipate will be finished in early June 2026, weather permitting. We will keep the community updated.

### Next steps

Once the necessary investigation and works have been completed, follow-up water testing will be done by the independent hygienist to ensure the water meets [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).
