Works notification | 13 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

As part of scheduled maintenance, we recently completed drinking water quality testing at Red Range Public School.

This test is conducted twice a year by an independent hygienist as a precautionary measure at schools that use potable tank water.

The routine test was completed on Wednesday 25 February 2026. The results, received on Wednesday 11 March 2026, identified the presence of copper in the sink tap in the practical activity area in Building A.

As a safety precaution, access to the affected sink tap has been restricted. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use this outlet. We are coordinating with your school to see if bottled water and hand sanitisers are required for students and staff.

At this time, no other drinking water outlets have been identified as affected.

Licensed and qualified contractors have been requested to attend site as a priority to carry out any necessary works. Once completed, follow-up water testing will be done by our independent hygienist to ensure the water is safe and meets [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).
