Works notification | 6 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the week beginning Monday 20 October 2025, members of staff reported discoloured water from a tap in the Building B programs room at Robertson Public School.

The school stopped using the tap as a precaution.

An independent hygienist took samples of water from across the school on Wednesday 29 October 2025.

Testing results received by the NSW Department of Education on Wednesday 5 November 2025 confirmed the presence of lead in the Building B programs room tap. All other tap outlets returned results that are within the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines.

As a precautionary safety measure, access to the affected outlet has been restricted.

We are working with a plumber and independent hygienist to undertake any necessary remediation work including the replacement of the tap and flushing of water lines.

Additional testing will be conducted following this work to ensure the water is safe for use. For more information on water quality and safety measures, please visit the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines website](#).

As an added precaution we will also be supplying bottled water until remediation works are completed and the water is confirmed to be safe for use.

Future plumbing work

The department is in the planning stage of replacing the older water pipes in multiple buildings at Robertson Public School.

It is expected that this work will be done over the 2025/26 Summer School Holidays, contractor availability and weather permitting.
