We would like to provide the Robertson Public School community with the following updates on recent works.

Canteen update

Further to the <u>29 August works notification</u>, the new canteen demountable is now expected to be ready for use in Week 3, Term 4, due to <u>rescheduled remediation work in</u> <u>September</u>.

The temporary canteen will remain on site until the new facility is operational.

Building B works

All Building B eave sheets – which contained bonded asbestos as listed in the school's asbestos register – were replaced during the Spring School Holidays.

NSW Health explains if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low risk.

All work with asbestos-containing materials followed the advice of an independent hygienist, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All relevant safety measures were in place while work was carried out.

The building was inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated and a clearance certificate has been issued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

We will continue to keep the community updated.
