Upcoming site establishment works

Following the project update issued in [February 2026](#), we are pleased to advise the demolition works of Building A is now finished. Site establishment will start on Monday 4 May 2026 for the next stage of the project.

Site establishment works will take approximately 2 weeks and will include:

- setting up temporary fencing and mesh hoarding
- setting up site office sheds and facilities, including walkways and builder amenities
- establishing temporary power and water supply to the site.

There will be increased construction activity on Thunderbolts Way during these initial works.
